We are aware that there will be many questions from our potential graduates and their families due to the recent extension of the school closure until May 4th. Please be assured that, as a school, we are working hard to ensure that our potential graduates continue to have opportunities to graduate and apply for post-secondary education if they choose.

The Ministry of Education and the school board have confirmed that, for this year only, the requirement of 40 hours of community service and literacy requirement has been suspended. Students who are currently enrolled in the Ontario Literacy Course in order to meet the literacy requirement do still need to achieve this credit in order to attain the 30 credits required for graduation. Students who still require community hours are encouraged to complete as many hours as possible by participating in initiatives that assure their health and safety such as letter-writing campaigns to seniors.
